Subject: Oration Test for filling up the vacancies for the post of Parliamentary Interpreter Grade – II in Lok Sabha Secretariat [Advt. No. 2/2017].

Joint Recruitment Cell vide advertisement No. 2/2017 invited applications for filling up the vacancies for the post of Parliamentary Interpreter Grade-II in Lok Sabha Secretariat as per details given below :-

The revised vacancy position for the post of Parliamentary Interpreter Grade-II is 09 (01 SC; 03 OBC; and 05 UR) (04 English/Hindi; 01 Dogri, 01 Kashmiri, 01 Konkani; 01 Santhali; and 01 Sindhi)

2. On scrutiny of the applications, 55 applicants for English/Hindi Stream and 01 applicant for Konkani Language have been found eligible. No candidate for Dogri, Kashmiri Santhali and Sindhi Languages has been found eligible. The list of eligible and ineligible candidates is being uploaded separately.

3. **The Oration Test of the eligible candidates for English/Hindi Stream and Konkani Language will be held on Saturday, the 10th June, 2017 in Parliament House Annexe (near Red Cross building and opposite to Transport Bhawan), New Delhi-110001.**

4. Call letters to eligible candidates are being issued separately by Speed Post. The candidates are requested to report to the Reception Office, Parliament House Annexe, New Delhi as per the time indicated in their call letter.

5. The Oration test will be of **200 marks**. The following will be assessed in terms of marks:-

- (i) Fluency
- (ii) Language content
- (iii) Style, pronunciation and accent
- (iv) Material content
- (v) Voice

All the above five component will carry equal marks. The minimum cut off percentages of Marks is 50% in each of the above-said components /parameters.

6. At the time of Oration Test, the candidates should bring one set of the photocopies of the following certificates **duly attested by a First Class Magistrate or Gazetted Officer :-**

- (i) Matriculation or equivalent examination certificate as proof of date of birth;
- (ii) Marks Sheets of educational qualification - Matriculation/Higher Secondary/Graduation/ Post Graduation and higher educational qualification, if any;
- (iii) Category/Caste Certificate (PH, SC, ST and OBC certificates), as the case may be.

[Other Backward Classes (OBC) means those communities as included and specified in the Central Government list of the backward classes. OBC certificate of a candidate must show that the caste the candidate belongs to is recognized as OBC under various Resolutions of the Ministry of Welfare, Government of India, and that the person does not belong to creamy layer section.

A candidate claiming to be belonging to OBC but not submitting OBC certificate which satisfy these two conditions will be treated as General Category candidate and will not be provided any benefit available to OBC candidates.]

In this connection, attention of the candidates is also drawn to para 5. XIV of the Advertisement No. 2/2017.

7. Besides above, in case of any discrepancy in the name (either of the candidate or her/his parents) including the spelling error or otherwise as recorded in the certificate(s), etc. and as mentioned in the application by the candidate, a self attested photocopy of an affidavit/gazette notification (as the case may be) to the effect that the name(s) belong to the one and the same person is to be submitted by the candidate alongwith the above said documents/certificates. Otherwise her/his candidature may be rejected.

8. Your candidature is provisional and may be cancelled at any time in case any declaration in your application does not match with the requirements advertised for the post. You are, therefore, required to satisfy yourself that you fulfil the eligibility conditions for the post, before attending the test. You are required to abide by the instructions that may be given to you in the Examination Hall at the time of Oration Test, failing which your candidature will be cancelled.

9. Mobile, other electronic gadgets and wireless equipments are banned within the premises of examination. Their possession by a candidate in switched on or switched off mode is considered by Lok Sabha Secretariat as a manipulative practice and will invite cancellation of her/his candidature and/or debarment from the examinations conducted by Lok Sabha Secretariat.

10. **The date(s) of examination for subsequent stage(s) only for those candidates who qualify the Oration Test will be fixed after the declaration of result of oration test.**
