Subject : Preliminary Examination for filling up the vacancies for the post of Printer on Direct Recruitment basis in Lok Sabha Secretariat. [Advt. No. 3/2017].

Lok Sabha Secretariat vide Advertisement No. 3/2017 inter-alia notified **05 vacancies (01 OBC and 04 UR)** for the post of Printer in Lok Sabha Secretariat to be filled up on Direct Recruitment basis.

2. The Preliminary Examination for the above-said post is scheduled to be held on **29.07.2017** in Parliament House Complex as per following details :-

Part -C	General Hindi	25	
Part- D	Proof Reading (25 <i>multiple Choice Objective Type Questions in each part</i>)	25	

The candidates will have to secure the minimum qualifying marks in each component and aggregate in the Preliminary Examination. The marks secured by the candidates in the Preliminary Examination will not be counted while preparing the final selection list. Only those candidates who secure the minimum qualifying marks in the Preliminary Examination will be allowed to appear in the Trade Test to be held on subsequent date(s).

3. Call letter(s) indicating the exact venue and time of the Preliminary Examination are being issued shortly to the eligible candidates.

4. The lists of eligible as well as ineligible candidates will also be uploaded on website in due course. The eligible candidates are advised to check their 'category' mentioned in the list and bring the discrepancy, if any, to the notice of JRC in writing at the time of Preliminary Examination.

5. At the time of the Preliminary Examination, the candidate must carry a valid photo ID proof such as PAN Card/Passport/Voter ID/Driving Licence/Aadhaar Card/Permanent Identity Card issued by a University/College or any other valid proof of identification having a latest photograph of the candidate alongwith the Call Letter issued by the Joint Recruitment Cell, Lok Sabha Secretariat.

6. It may please be noted that mobile phone, other electronic gadgets and wireless equipments will not be allowed inside the venue of the Test. Their possession by a candidate in switched on or switched off mode is considered by the Lok Sabha Secretariat as a manipulative practice and will invite cancellation of her/his candidature and/or debarment from the examinations conducted by Lok Sabha Secretariat. The candidates are advised in their own interest **NOT** to bring these items to the venue of the Preliminary Examination as no arrangement for safekeeping of these items are being made. Hence, Lok Sabha Secretariat shall not be responsible for any loss in this regard.
