Subject : First Stage Screening of eligible candidates for filling up the vacancies for the posts of Housekeeper Grade-III/Farrash in Lok Sabha Secretariat [Advt. No.5 /2017].

Lok Sabha Secretariat vide Advertisement No. 5/2017 notified 28 vacancies [02 ST, 09 OBC and 17 UR] for the posts of Housekeeper Grade-III and Farrash [27 Housekeeper Grade-III and 01 Farrash] to be filled up on Direct Recruitment basis in Lok Sabha Secretariat.

2. The First Stage Screening of the eligible candidates is scheduled to be held from 22 July, 2017 onwards in Parliament House Complex, New Delhi.
3. The lists of eligible as well as ineligible candidates will be uploaded shortly. The eligible candidates are advised to check their 'category' mentioned in the list and bring the discrepancy, if any, to the notice of Joint Recruitment Cell in writing at the time of First Stage Screening.
4. Call letter(s) indicating the exact venue and time of the First Stage Screening are being issued to the eligible candidates.
5. The First Stage Screening will be of 50 marks. Only those candidates who qualify in the first Stage Screening will be called for the Second Stage Screening. The marks secured by the candidates in the 1st Stage Screening will not be counted for final selection.
6. At the time of the Screening(s), the candidate must carry a valid photo ID proof such as PAN Card/Passport/Voter ID/Driving Licence/Aadhaar Card/Permanent Identity Card issued by a University/College or any other valid proof of identification having a latest photograph of the candidate alongwith the Call Letter issued by the Joint Recruitment Cell, Lok Sabha Secretariat.
7. Attempts to influence or pressurise the selection process including canvassing in any manner would lead to summary rejection of the candidature.
8. It may please be noted that mobile phone, and other electronic gadgets and wireless equipments will not be allowed inside the venue of the Screening Test. Their possession by a candidate in switched on or switched off mode is considered by the Lok Sabha Secretariat as a manipulative practice and will invite cancellation of her/his candidature and or debarment from the examinations conducted by Lok Sabha Secretariat. The candidates are advised in their own interest NOT to bring these items to the venue of the Screening Test as no arrangement for safekeeping of these items have been made. Hence, Lok Sabha Secretariat shall not be responsible for any loss in this regard.
