3. The eligible candidates may please download their e-admission/call letter from the Website <http://www.loksabha.nic.in> under the link Recruitment → Download admit card. The applicant must have her/his registration number and date of birth for the purpose of downloading of admit card.

The candidate should bring a print out of the admit card with her/him at the examination venue(s) without fail, duly affixing thereon the same passport size photograph (in original) which had been uploaded by her/him while applying for the above-said post. The candidate shall put her/his signature and left hand thumb impression at the space provided/earmarked thereon in the examination hall in the presence of invigilator.

**5. The candidates are directed to bring and submit copies of degrees/mark sheets and other certificates as detailed/enlisted under point no. 6 of the instructions in the Admit Card and hand over the same to the invigilator at the venue of Typing Test. The candidates belonging to OBC category will be required to submit a declaration attached with call letter in addition to the category/community certificate.**

6. The candidates are also advised to download the instructions alongwith the admit card and carefully read them and scrupulously follow the same at the time of appearing in the main examination.

7. The admit card will be collected from you on the day of Paper-I i.e. 24.02.2018. Therefore, please keep a photocopy of this admit card for the purpose to facilitate entry/appearing in Paper-II on 25.02.2018.
