New Delhi, 14 November 2017: Lok Sabha Speaker Smt. Sumitra Mahajan led the Parliamentarians in paying floral tributes at the portrait of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru in the Central Hall of Parliament House on his birth anniversary today.
